

Guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in regards to the Coronavirus:

As a reminder, the CDC always recommends everyday actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory illness, including:

- *Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- *Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- *Stay home when you are sick.
- *Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- *Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- *Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

Parents should discuss the above precautions with their children and institute these recommendations at home; likewise, teachers will be informed to implement them within school.



CHINUCH THOUGHTS

The Torah, in describing the Bigdei Kehuna, tell us that the Kohen Gadol carried the names of the Bnei Yisroel on his shoulders – engraved on the Avnei Shoham of the Efod and on his heart – carved into the stones of the Choshen.

The positioning of the names of the Shvotim at these locations represents the love (לב) and responsibility (כתפיו) the Kohen Gadol felt for Klall Yisroel. It also bears a message to us parents and teachers.

The love we have for our children must not be a shortsighted and reckless love but rather a responsible one. Additionally, our responsibilities to them must be carried out in a spirit of love rather than as a burden and inconvenience.

Giving in to every whim and fancy of our children, when it isn't in their best interest, might be viewed as "Ahava" – but it doesn't reflect "Achrayos" and is therefore an irresponsible love (חטא בלא אפוד). Taking our roles of parental responsibility so seriously that it doesn't take into account the individuality and uniqueness of every child, is "Achrayos" without "Ahava" (אפוד בלא חטא).

Our challenge as parents and educators is to maintain a proper balance between the two. The תפארת בגדים בהונאה was the synthesis (חטא ו דין) of both תפארת.

Purim in particular, poses a tremendous challenge to our ability to exercise this blend of Ahava and Achrayos, both on a personal and parental level.

Chazal say that on Purim we reaffirmed our commitment to Torah out of free will and love, as opposed to Har Sinai which contained an element of coercion. Indeed, Purim with its Mitzvos Hayom and accompanying merriment and festive spirit reflects this level of Ahavas Hashem and Ahavas Hatorah. At the same time, however, we must ensure that this Ahava is expressed with a sense of Achrayos – responsibility for our own actions as well as our children's.

Driving recklessly, drinking irresponsibly, double parking, blocking driveways, incessant honking, littering streets and sidewalks, playing loud music and screaming at the top of our lungs late into the night and early hours of the morning, or in general acting as if we are the only people living in the neighborhood, are examples of outright "Chilul Hashem" not expressions of "Ahavas Hashem" and an example of Ahava without Achrayos.

This Purim let's all make a special effort to put some more Achrayos into our Ahava so that Purim can once again be the elevated and meaningful day it was intended to be.




5TH GRADE ROSH CHODESH ADAR PERFORMANCE/TRANSFORMATION
