CHINUCH THOUGHTS

מדבר שקר ורחק (בג, ז)

איסור המפורשים point out that this posuk is unique. It is the only that the Torah tells us to distance ourselves from. With every other aveiro, it is Chazal that add הרכחות וסיגנים - fences and additional safeguards to keep us away from the שקר. When it comes to the Torah itself says רחק - distance yourself. This, says the Chofetz Chaim, is to show the importance of being truthful and how much Hashem abhors the slightest deviation from the truth.

The Shla Hakadosh says that the primary role of parents is to instill in their children the מידת Emes. Successful Chinuch in this area begins with the parents. This is not only in our dealings with others but also in our interaction with our children. Chazal say that one should not promise to give something to a child and then not give it because it teaches the child that it is acceptable to lie.

The Chinuch in Middas HaEmes also includes how much emphasis the home places on being truthful. When parents follow school rules and guidelines clearly stated in the school handbook, i.e. exposure to media, standards of tznius for both students and parents, winter break schedules, carpool procedures, etc. then a child uses it as a guide for their behavior as well. If, however the child is given the impression that what the Hanholo doesn't know or see is acceptable, the child then gets a very different message.

This is especially challenging when a family's personal life-style is not aligned with the hashkofo and the standards of the Yeshiva. It results in the attitude that it's acceptable to live a double life. It also results in the child being told by their parents to not be truthful to the school as to the standards of the home which could hamper the Yeshiva's ability to instill them with Torah and Yiras Shomayim.

The Torah is referred to as a *תורת אמת*. The more sensitive we are to the importance of *אמת* the more successful we will be in teaching the importance of Torah.

Chazal say that after one hundred and twenty years a person will first be asked whether they were honest and truthful in their dealings with others. The next question will be whether they devoted time to Limud Hatorah. Our role as parents/mechanchim is to prepare our children to be able to confidently answer yes to both. Much depends on the importance we attach to them as well.
