Where we have been: Over the last four years, the following programs and activities have been offered to our keiki, youth and families. Please rate each program's impact on you, your family, or those you may know and rate its importance to continue to be a part of the ministry on an ongoing basis, setting aside the current restrictions due to Covid-19.

TextBlock:

Age 0-4Nursery - The Nursery program is offered on Sundays at St. James' from 8:30 to 10:30 AM and is staffed by trained volunteers. On average we have had 2 children weekly.

Age 4 - 13Godly Play and Sunday School - Based on Montessori principles, Godly Play is offered at St. James' on Sundays from 8:55 to 10:15, and is staffed by trained volunteers. On average we have had 8 children at St. James' and 3 to 5 children at St. Columba's for Sunday School, which is not currently using a set curriculum.

Vacation Bible School - Annual program held in 3rd week of July, lasting 5 days, staffed by Coordinator, clergy and volunteers. Held on the campus at St. James'. Includes a meal at the end of each day for families, to help out parents as they are busy preparing for the beginning of school. School supplies are given out on last day. Participants capped for last two years at 50, with waiting list.

Fall follow up program to VBS - Family night program. Coordinator, volunteers. St. James' campus. Average participants 40 children, plus their families. Includes a meal.

Lent/Easter Programs - includes burying alleluias, Easter day program and resurrecting alleluias and a family evening program, which includes a meal. Some activities conducted on both St. James' and St. Columba's campuses. Coordinator, clergy, staff, volunteers. Average participants 40 children and their families for last year's Easter on the Green program. 40 children and families for evening program.

Advent & Christmas Programs, including Christmas Eve Pageant and family evening program, which includes a meal. Average 40 participants.

TextBlock:

Grades 1-6After School Tutoring Program - conducted by volunteers, St. James' campus. Weekly on Wednesday afternoons, during school year, includes snacks and one on one homework assistance, as well as structured play time. Average Attendance 8 to 10.

Grades 2 - 6Spring Break Camp (Kamp Kamuela) - Bi-annual (every other year) program held during school spring break for 5 days, typically including off campus programs such as canoe paddling, horseback riding, etc. Staffed by Coordinator and volunteers. Limited to 20 participants due to limitations on busing. Breakfast and Lunch provided.

Grades 6 to 12Time for Teens and Movies with a Message (initiated in September 2019, has not met since Covid-19 restrictions imposed in March.)Clergy and volunteers. Average participants 4
