## Notice of Proposed Change to Membership

As noted earlier this season a call for membership review was made at the 2019 Annual General meeting. The first step taken was the creation of the Social Membership, which although only taken by one member this season, will continue for future years.

In review of our options, the Tennis Board is recommending a change to the Club By-law which will increase from membership from the current 110 members to a new limit of 120 memberships, and now seek the approval of the general membership by way of an email poll to be closed as of October 30th, 2020.

In order to pass this proposed change, according to the By- Laws, we will require a quorum of 20 memberships voting, exclusive of those held by Board members, of which a simple majority will determine the outcome. As an email vote was considered the most convenient option for the majority of people, the Board hopes to see a high level of participation in this vote.

It should be noted that over the past five years on average there has been at least three or four families seeking membership each season while only one or two spots open up. Currently there are four families seeking membership. During this same period court usage has declined as our membership ages, and it is important for the future of the Club to be able to attract and accommodate new members, whether new to our community or simply current families seeking addition playing time.
