CURRENT CART RULES: SUMMER/FALL 2025

These are the current cart rules for the use of carts on the golf courses during a round of golf for the 2025 summer/fall golf season at SaddleBrooke One. They may be adjusted at any time as needed, based on play levels and course conditions. The goal of these rules is to provide as much access to the courses as possible while controlling traffic and protecting plant health and ultimately playing conditions on the courses. It is every golfer's responsibility to follow the current rules and all course signage. Please see SaddleBrooke One golf staff for clarification or questions at any time. Golf staff will be actively enforcing the rules on the course daily. <u>We encourage golfers to pair up whenever possible to improve your playing experience and reduce the number of carts on the golf course</u>. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding.

- 1. <u>No Cart Zones</u>: These areas are marked by a yellow line. For the safety of all golfers and turf preservation, **NO CARTS ARE ALLOWED PAST THE YELLOW LINES**
- 2. <u>Modified Gate System</u>: Entry to the turf is allowed at any point after the tees. All carts should remain on the cart path as long as possible before entering the turf. A system of exit gates is provided at the end of each par 4 and par 5 fairway. ALL CARTS MUST EXIT THROUGH THE GATES. This system gives the maintenance staff the ability spread traffic patterns on a daily basis and protects areas of the course from repeated traffic damage.
- 3. <u>2 Carts Per hole on the turf</u>: In the event your group has more than 2 carts, only two carts will be allowed on the turf at a time. This includes the rough and the fairway turf. This includes medical flag carts (SEE MEDICAL FLAG EXCEPTIONS BELOW). Carts may switch throughout the hole with other carts up to the exit gate, but only 2 carts at a time on the turf.
- 4. <u>Weekly/daily hole closures to some or all traffic</u>: Some or all traffic may be limited on certain holes on each course (SEE MEDICAL FLAG EXCEPTIONS BELOW). The holes will be rotated based on turf conditions. PLEASE FOLLOW ALL POSTED SIGNS. This system has been very effective through the years at giving holes a much-needed break from large amounts of traffic and allowing time for turf recovery.
- 5. <u>Cart traffic in the rough</u>: All carts have access to the rough up to the NO CART ZONES, but only 2 carts may be on the turf at one time.

- 6. <u>Medical Flag exceptions</u>: The following exceptions are available to medical flag carts only:
 - a. Medical flags do have access to the par 3 holes where available, however THE NO CART ZONES MUST BE FOLLOWED.
 - b. Medical flags will have access to regular cart path only holes, however some holes may be closed to all traffic including medical flag carts. PLEASE FOLLOW ALL POSTED SIGNS.
