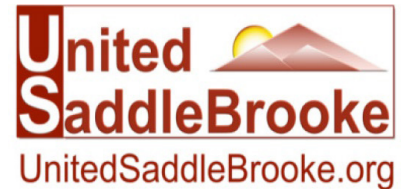

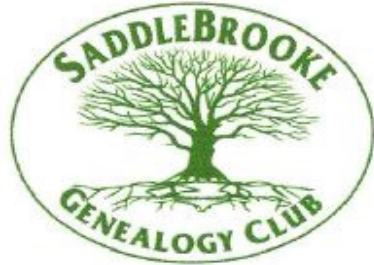


## SaddleBrooke Computer Club is modifying its summer program
