



RCTA is searching for an ACE Instructor (Academic Tutor) for its summer 2019 NJTL summer tennis outreach program. This 6-week program offers group tennis instruction and ACE enrichment lessons once a week for up to 25 youth age 6-12 at seven partner summer camp locations in Eden and Reidsville.\*

The ACE Instructor will be responsible for the academic enrichment portion of the summer NJTL Program and help promote participation in the USTA Foundation Essay Contest.

Academic Creative Engagement (ACE), developed by [National Junior Tennis & Learning \(NJTL\)](#) is an out-of-school academic curriculum connected to 21st century skills, Common Core State and National Standards and the sport of tennis. ACE is designed to support academic achievement, health/wellness and social/emotional skills and is accredited by the National Councils of Teachers of Mathematics and English. Lessons range from multi-cultural literacy texts to kinetic geometry exercises performed on the tennis court. Learning is active, hands-on and connects to learners with varied learning styles.

**Responsibilities:**

- Instruct and supervise students from seven summer day camps during ACE enrichment time (45 minutes-1 hour lessons).
- Implement the ACE curriculum and develop lesson plans that reflect the ACE curriculum
- Responsible for making sure that all needed materials are ordered and available at each location.
- Set up activities and materials before each session's program and clean up before leaving each session
- Handle discipline fairly with firmness but understanding and make sure that RCTA and summer camp staff is aware of any discipline issues
- Complete required assessments

**Qualifications:**

- Direct experience working with children ages 9-11
- Commitment to enhancing the lives of children through academics, social emotional learning and health and wellness
- Ability to think creatively and work collaboratively
- Ability to demonstrate and explain hands-on and experiential learning
- Strong written, verbal and presentation skills
- Engaging personality, ethical, team player and self-motivated
- Teaching certificate preferred
