### **Morehead High School wins 2019 RCS County Boys Tennis Tournament**

On March 28, 2019, the 2019 Rockingham County High School Boys Tennis Tournament was hosted at Jaycee Park in Reidsville and Rockingham Community College in Wentworth by Rockingham County Tennis Association with a grant from the Xerox Foundation. The tournament gave all high school boys players from the 4 RCS high school teams a chance to show how well they can play the game and compete against other players from across the county. The tournament is set up as a round robin based on seeds 1-7 for singles and 1-3 in doubles. Each seed has a chance to earn up to 3 points for their respective school and a medal for first place. Second place earned 2 points and a medal, while third place earned one point. The play was spirited and competitive. The overall winner was Morehead High School (JMHS) with 23 points. Number 2 was Rockingham County High School (RCHS) with 19 points, Number 3 McMichael (DMHS) with 10 points. Number 4 Reidsville (RHS) with 9 points.
