

## TEXT FROM M.O. 17/2020

AEP is temporarily suspending the following in accordance with the lapsing provisions in the Ministerial Order, unless otherwise communicated to you in writing:

- All requirements to report information pursuant to provisions in approvals or registrations authorized under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* (EPEA), except in the case of drinking water facilities.
- All requirements to report information pursuant to provisions in licences or approvals authorized under the *Water Act* except in the case of drinking water facilities.
- All requirements to submit returns or reports as required under a formal disposition under the *Public Lands Act* (PLA).

During this period of temporary suspensions, parties shall continue to record and retain complete documentation. This information shall be made available to Environment and Parks upon request. All unauthorized substance releases that have the potential to cause an adverse effect by impairing or damaging the environment, human health, safety or property must be reported to the Environmental and Dangerous Goods Emergencies (EDGE) line at 780-422-4505. Readers should consult original documentation to ensure maintaining compliance.
