Be able to communicate well and in a friendly manner with the pastor, staff, Adult Choir and members of the congregation.

Job Performance Requirements:

- Provide organ and Clavinova (keyboard) music in a professional manner for weekly Sunday worship services (9:30 a.m.) and all seasonal and special services, some of which are evening services - specifically during Advent, Christmas, Lent and Holy Week.
- With the Pastor, assist in the selection of music and liturgies and submit them for worship presentation in a timely manner.
- Provide organ and Clavinova (keyboard) music for weddings and funerals and be permitted to receive additional compensation from the parties involved.
- Lead congregational singing and worship through the excellent execution of songs, hymns and liturgy.
- Encourage the musical talents and participation of members of the congregation through organizing and coordinating special musical offerings, including soloists, instrumentalists, and small ensembles in cooperation with the Board of Worship and music ministry group.
- Other worship related duties as assigned.

- 1. Select music, rehearse and direct the Adult Choir for at least one anthem per month, including weekly evening rehearsals September through May.
