This role involves organizing fundraising initiatives, working with board members, and building relationships with foundations, donors, staff and volunteers. Much of the role is producing strategic and timely documents for foundations and other funders.

Our ideal candidate has a minimum of two years of fund development experience, preferably in the political or nonprofit fields. They should also be familiar with Microsoft and Google suite, and be comfortable asking people for money. Clear, concise, and persuasive writing skills are a must have.

The salary range is \$50,000 - \$58,000, depending on experience. There's an opportunity for increase upon a 1-year performance review.

Job Responsibilities: The Development Director, based in Milwaukee, would **develop and maintain strong and strategic relationships**, lead on all **fundraising written materials**, direct **individual donor plan**, and lead the staff and board in meeting big and exciting goals.

- Serve as liaison to primary funding partners and national networks and, in coordination with progressive partner organizations, provide regular updates to local and national funders.
- Research and identify sources of funding in close collaboration with partners and their respective leadership and fund development staff.
- Be a part of developing a plan for ongoing financial viability for the organization as well as key coalition work.
- Assist in overall financial management and oversight, including systems for accounting and reporting on revenues and expenditures on a regular basis.
- Produce all fundraising related materials, including foundation LOIs, grant proposals, reports, and updates like the annual report and quarterly updates.
- Be a strategic sounding board to find and execute creative or new ways to raise money for the organization's or our partners' priorities.
- Set annual goals with the ED and create a plan to carry out individual donor plan to reach goals.
- Ensure strong fundraising systems / administration and that ED, staff and board has the support she needs to meet the annual goals.

- Work with ED to schedule funder and donor meetings.
- Design and execute an individual donor strategy, with ED and staff as partners.
- Communicate with funders donors and staff via email, phone, mail and social media.
- Answer all donor or funder inquires in a timely fashion.
