The Public Health Specialist implements and evaluates public health services and grant programs for a comprehensive approach to community-based health planning, programming and preparedness. This position develops community partnerships, conducts community educational programs, coordinates public health programming and communicates public health messaging. Responsibilities also include implementation of the community assessment, community health improvement plan, health planning and accreditation.

Bachelor's degree in public health, health education, health planning, epidemiology, health administration, nursing, or other health-related field. Master's degree in Public Health or related field preferred. Professional experience in public health, including experience with data analysis or program planning is a plus. The salary range is \$55,120 – \$62,400 annually.

The Cudahy Health Department is a Level III status following the Chapter 140 Review, and is diligently working towards accreditation through the Public Health Accreditation Board. We offer many diverse programs to meet the needs of the community.

The City encompasses 4.7 square miles and has a population of 18,267. The City is governed by a full-time Mayor and five Alderpersons. Cudahy is served by one school district and enjoys great parks.
