The US Department of Justice defines Human Trafficking as a crime involving the exploitation of a person for labor, services, or commercial sex. Human trafficking occurs all over Wisconsin with cases being documented in all 72 counties in our state. In 2017, there were over 90 cases of Human Trafficking reported in Wisconsin. However, no one knows exactly how often this crime occurs because often times it goes unreported.

The conference presenters will address:

- Law enforcement response to human trafficking
- Outreach for special populations related to human trafficking
- Overviews of evidenced based practices to assist in meeting the needs of survivors of human trafficking including the Seven Essential Ingredients (7ei) of Trauma Informed Care

Who should attend? PATH, SOAR, and CoC Agencies, Human Services Professionals, Law Enforcement, Clinicians and Social Workers, anyone interested in learning more on human trafficking.
