Children will seek advice about how to handle high pressure situations if they don't feel judged or falsely accused.

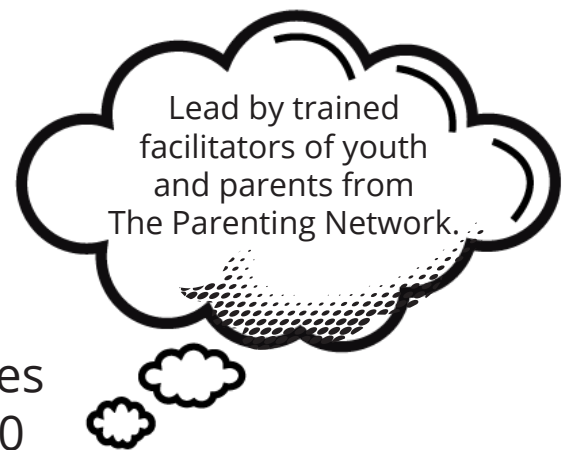
