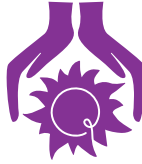




Last year, 130 adult victims of domestic violence and 93 children were provided with shelter and comprehensive services through our Emergency Shelter; 98% of adults developed a safety plan prior to leaving shelter; 79% of families received housing counseling and successfully transitioned from shelter to their own safe, stable housing; 65% elected to receive aftercare services; 94% reported feeling more confident in their decision making skills; 87% felt they could achieve goals that they had set for themselves and their families; 92% increased their awareness and knowledge of resources they could use in the future and 86% acquired knowledge about their rights and options in the legal system.
