### Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Serving as the Lead Teaching Artist for select workshops and residencies in the Amani Neighborhood
- Leading as the liaison between Amani neighborhood meetings and Rep Education, attending neighborhood events, maintaining clear communications, leading listening sessions on how arts programming can best support the Amani Revitalization Plan.
- Developing curriculum and programming as assigned
- Collecting work and anecdotal evidence for assessment and reporting purposes
- Maintaining ongoing communication with Education staff and program partners, including completing and submitting bi-weekly check-ins, timesheets, and attending Teaching Artist meetings
- Attending Rep productions associated with Education programming
- Additional duties as assigned by the Education Manager

1. Bachelor's degree OR equivalent years of teaching experience OR equivalent years with community organizing or public service
2. Ideal candidates will have experience in theater education with strong teaching skills and experience with middle and high school students
3. Experience with supporting neighborhood events and upholding resident interests
4. Ability to manage schedule to participate in a variety of classes and meetings each week
5. Ability to follow a set curriculum as well as create material preferred
6. Excellent verbal and written communication skills
7. Ability to pass a background check in accordance with state and federal laws
