Discussion of Speaker

- UCC - residential treatment, groups. Got thinking if only know about UCC, what about other places? Not everyone at prevention stage, people also need intervention
- Joyce - prevention and treatment has been 2 different silos, do need to make referrals. When identify youth who are struggling, there was supposed to be a referral list - Jeremy was working on? Pamphlet was in final stage?
- Chovonne - does seem to be silos between orgs - how to streamline and bring together?
- Janet - goal is keep severity and risk to a minimum, keep families in tact, reduce symptoms, SBIRT is an opportunity. Earlier can intervene, the better. Don't want people to go to residential treatment or criminal justice system if can be prevented.

- Rx Drug Group
 - Most new members, did background and brainstorming
 - Strong representative from people who work in treatment and recovery
- Data Group
 - Discussed breaking down silos between primary prevention and treatment and recovery, both inform each other
 - Helps community to have data from treatment and recovery to plan prevention activities
 - Nicole has data on linking people from ED/overdose to treatment services
