The reproductive health nurse practitioner is responsible for the planning and administration of quality health care in the reproductive and health setting. The Nurse Practitioner works to ensure that high quality care is delivered in a customer service driven environment. This position will provide primary health care and case management in the area of family planning; provide for initiation and maintenance of clients in the family planning regimen; collaborate with other professionals, partner organizations and citizen groups in developing the family planning program; and serve as team leader for other agency personnel in the provision of family planning services.

Certification in Reproductive Health or at least a Master of Science in Nursing as an Advanced Nurse Prescriber is required. Current Wisconsin license to practice as a Registered Nurse and Advance Practice Nurse Prescriber. Experience as a Women's Health Nurse Practitioner in a public health setting preferred. The salary range is \$87,360 - \$114,400. This is grant funded position with a current two year appointment with options for extension.

The Cudahy Health Department is a Level III status following the Chapter 140 Review, and is diligently working towards accreditation through the Public Health Accreditation Board. We offer many diverse programs to meet the needs of the community.

The City encompasses 4.7 square miles and has a population of 18,267. The City is governed by a full-time Mayor and five Alderpersons. Cudahy is served by one school district and enjoys great parks.
