- Cell phones and earbuds should not be visible in class.



- Reach out for help if you are struggling with attendance.



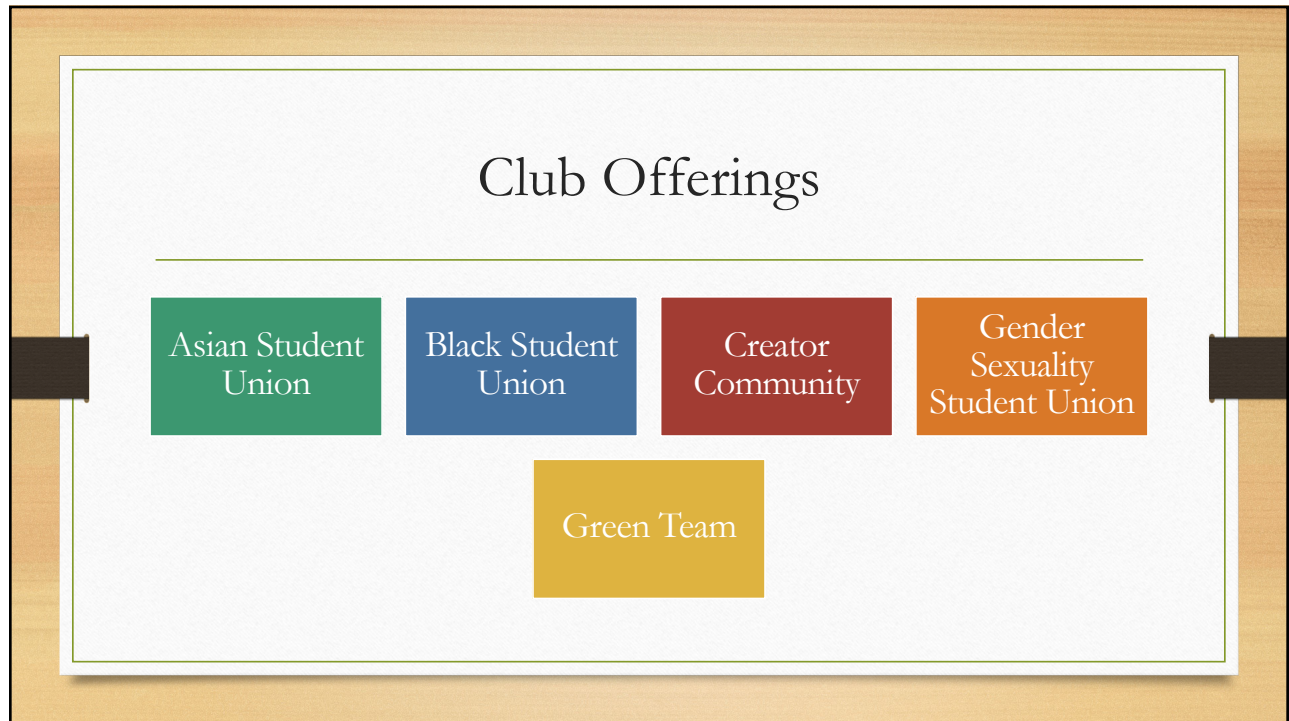
