This heartbreaking story just arrived from one of our church partners.

"This prayer request is filled with tears, gratitude to God, and the hopes and prayers of our church family. We invite you to join us in lifting these prayers to the Lord.

We lift up prayers for our brother-in-arms, Sasha Stets. For those of us who know him personally, we witnessed his deep desire to shine as a light in the very darkness of war where God placed him. For three years, he faithfully defended Ukraine as a soldier in the Armed Forces.

Now, he urgently needs our prayers, support, and care.

During his last combat mission, Sasha suffered catastrophic injuries. A severe shelling left him with both legs amputated, the loss of fingers on one hand, multiple shrapnel wounds, and serious damage to his eyes.

He is now in a safe place where doctors are providing professional treatment and have already performed many surgeries. One of the most pressing requests is prayer for the restoration of his eyesight and for God's hand over the entire healing process.

Sasha's wife, Yulia, has been by his side faithfully. She, too, needs our prayers—that the Lord will grant her courage, strength, and endurance as she walks this difficult path with her husband.

We thank God for sparing Sasha's life and ask you to continue praying for his recovery and rehabilitation. Sasha and his family desperately need the support of God's people.

We also believe the Lord is preparing Sasha for a powerful future ministry among war veterans. Pray that God will redeem this suffering and use Sasha's life as a testimony of hope and faith to many."
