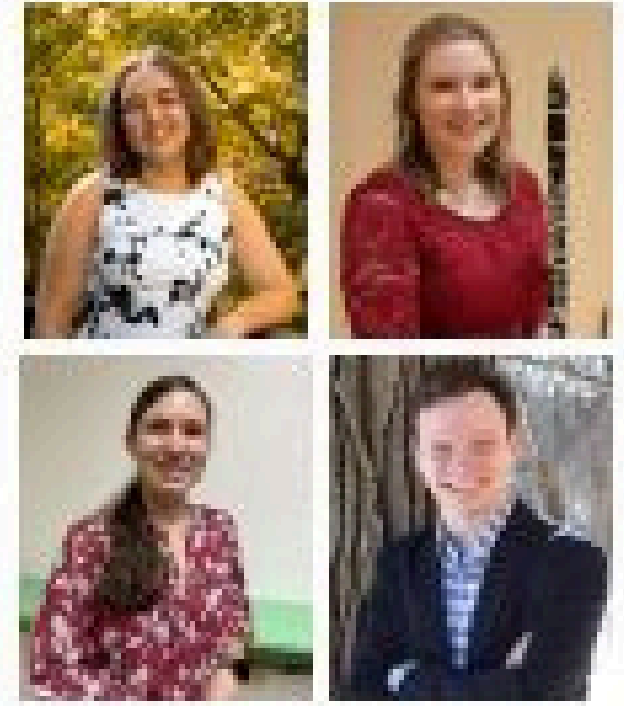




A “note” from the SDWD Elementary Music Department
