- Students should come prepared with basic materials for the day, bringing:
 - School locks purchased from the Mustang Store ONLY (Locker assignments will be issued)
 - o iPads
 - o Pen/Pencil (Teachers will inform students of supplies needed for the year during Orientation)
- During the morning hours students will meet their teachers and receive class information.
 - o Every freshman will receive a class schedule and will be guided to class locations.
- Following lunch students will receive school safety training and learn other school policies.
- During the afternoon hours students will meet their Big Brother and take part in team building.
 - o Students will receive a Freshman Orientation t-shirt to wear in the afternoon.
