The following are guidelines that all licensed student drivers are required to follow. All student drivers and their parent(s)/guardian(s) are required to sign a parking contract before a parking permit will be issued. Parking on campus is a privilege. Vehicles that have not been registered may be ticketed.

Guidelines:

- 1. All vehicles parked on school grounds must be registered with the school and display the current parking pass on the rearview mirror facing out. A Driver's License is required to register a vehicle.
- 2. Parking pass numbers correspond with the numbered parking spaces. Students must park in their assigned space.
- 3. Transfer of a pass to another student's car is not allowed and will result in the parking pass being revoked. NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE.
- 4. Students are to enter and exit the parking lot from the McDonald's Drive unless otherwise noted by school officials.
- 5. Students are not allowed to use their vehicles as lockers and are not allowed to go to their vehicles during the school day without the permission from the Dean of Students.
- 6. Students are to report any accidents to the Dean of Students or St. Rita Security immediately.
- 7. Students are not allowed to park their vehicles overnight without permission from school officials.
- 8. Students are to follow standard vehicle driving laws and the established parking lot pattern designed by school officials. The posted speed limit is not to be exceeded in the parking lot.
