Thursday, November 19

Jnana Panchmi—(JAINISM)—(Day of Acquiring Knowledge) Some Jains celebrate transcendent wisdom by fasting for 36 hours. Others perform rituals and pray for right knowledge.

Sunday, November 22

Qawl—(BAHA'I')—(Speech), the fourteenth month of the Baha'i' year.

Tuesday, November 24

Martyrdom of Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji—(SIKHISM)—This day commemorates the martyrdom of Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji (1621-1675), the ninth of the Ten Sikh Gurus. He is remembered not only for his defense of the Sikh faith, but also for willingly giving up his life for religious liberty for all faiths.

Wednesday, November 25

Day of the Covenant—(BAHA'I')—celebrates the anniversary of the appointment of 'Abdu'l-Baha, the son of Baha'u'llah, as the Center of the Covenant. (Baha'is do not suspend work on this day.)

Month of November

Kaskatinowipisim—(ABORIGINAL SPIRITUALITY)—(Freeze-up Moon) This month when the weather gets cold enough that lakes and rivers become frozen over. (Cree)
