



## CAR Foundation Receives Grant from REALTOR® Relief Foundation to Help with Colorado Wildfires

The CAR Foundation, in conjunction with the Colorado Association of REALTORS®, was awarded a \$100,000 grant by the National Association of REALTORS'® REALTOR® Relief Foundation to help individuals and families affected by the East Troublesome, Calwood, and Cameron Peak Fires (Boulder, Grand and Larimer counties).

Qualified applicants can receive up to \$1,000 to be used exclusively for a monthly mortgage expense on a primary residence or rental housing cost due to displacement from a primary residence or rental relocation resulting from a qualified fire area.

Grants will be disbursed on a weekly basis. However, it could take up to two weeks to receive the certified check by mail. Checks will be jointly payable to applicant and mortgage lender or landlord.

Funds will be available on a first come, first serve basis and will be available beginning immediately through February 15, 2021.
