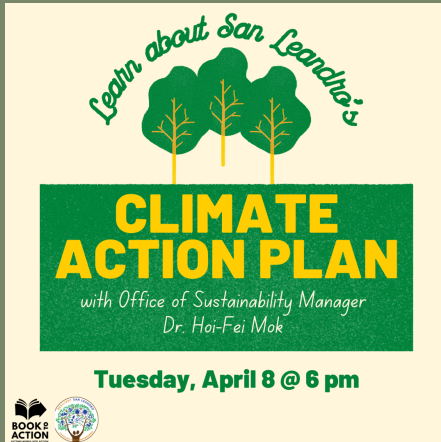

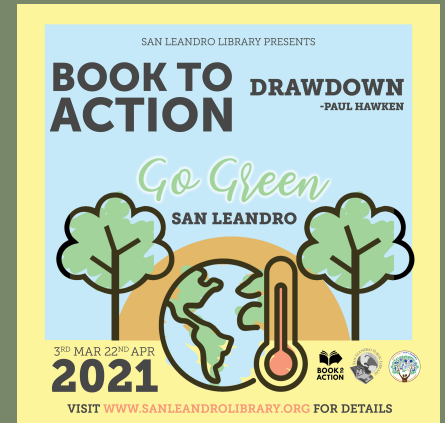

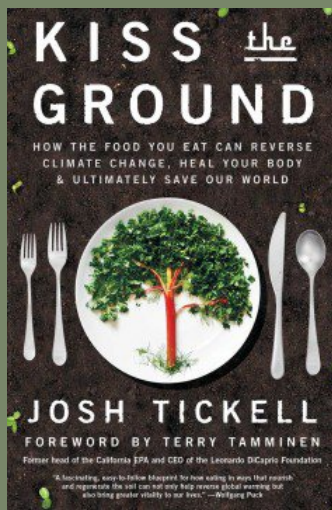
Learn about the Climate Action Plan!
