

ELEVATOR REPLACEMENTS

72nd Street Subway Station



To improve customer experience and modernize the transit system, the MTA is replacing elevators at various stations throughout the transit system.

Construction Activities Begin on or About Monday

August 25, 2025 at the 72nd Street Subway Station

Two elevators that provide access to uptown and downtown 1,2, & 3 train platforms from the mezzanine level will be closed and removed for new replacements. This work begins on or about Monday, August 25, 2025.

Temporary barricades will be placed throughout the station as part of the work. The agent booth will remain operational during regular hours.

A 90-foot staging area will be established along the subway station on Verdi Path. Verdi Path will remain open & accessible to pedestrians. This staging area will remain in place through **Q1 of 2026**. The elevator will be out of service through **Q1 of 2026**.
