Join us for these family-friendly Spring Clean tasks:

- ♣ Big Wagon – pull weeds and odd little samplings (don't pull the perennials like the Russian Sage)
- ♣ Rake Leaves – Rake and bag up two large piles of leaves in the two NE corners of the parking lot
- ♣ Rain Garden – Rake and bag leaves throughout the rain garden; pull all obvious weeds and any “regular” lawn grass that has started growing there (not the ornamental grass)
- ♣ Small Area – (immediately west of rain garden) – rake and bag leaves; pull weeds; put down paper sacks/newspaper; cover with mulch (bags of mulch will already be there; just need to be spread out)
- ♣ Wildflower Garden #1 (WG1) – reposition metal arbor; position broken pavers as a little path; general light weeding; repair bird bath
- ♣ Wildflower Garden #2 (WG2) – Disassemble makeshift bench (move cinderblocks to garden area by playground)
- ♣ General Tasks – walk the campus grounds and pick up fallen tree limbs, sticks, etc.

What to Bring:

- Your family!
- A few garden tools if you have them (gloves, trowels to dig up weeds, rake, larger shovel, etc.)

What We'll Provide:

- Paper lawn sacks & Mulch
- Large trailer to haul away all the leaves/lawn debris (thank you, Martig Family)
