





Please drive slowly around the campus and the neighboring community.


**THREE-POINT TURNS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CHEVY CHASE

Beginning at 8:55 am

A teacher will meet your car; parents should not get out of the car. Children should be ready to get out of the car quickly, backpacks ready, etc.

Drop-off is at the end of the playground near the swings. In inclement weather, a sign will be in the alley asking you to please drop off at the double doors in the alley.

Walkers should go to the main gate entrance adjacent to the lobby to begin their day.

If you arrive after 9:08 a.m., please park on the street and drop off your child from the playground walker entrance (main gate).

Health and Safety Protocols


We ask parents to carefully monitor their child's health and keep sick children home.

A fever always means stay home until the child has been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication.

Diarrhea/Vomiting always means stay home until the symptom has resolved without the use of medication. Teachers who notice signs of illness will alert the office and parents will be notified to pick up their child as needed.

Please communicate any diagnosed communicable diseases to the office via email.

Any positive cases are required to isolate for 5 days and return on day 6.


Positive cases are required to be masked for 5 days upon return.

Our Extended Day classes fill the afternoon with more play and learning as children gather with friends to enjoy a lunch from home, and lots of socializing and fun until 2:30 each day.

These classes are available to our older children in the Woodland and Creekside programs.

Parent Participation Opportunities



- **Classroom Volunteer (for Woodland and Creekside Programs):** Enjoy a full morning helping in the classroom or stop in and share a book or a cooking project for 15-30 minutes. We are an inclusive community and look forward to sharing your cultural traditions and customs with your children's classmates. Teachers coordinate schedules for parent participation to fit with lesson planning.
- **Field Trip Chaperone:** Driving and chaperoning are essential in getting everyone to our destinations as the children learn about our broader community.
- **Room Parent:** Room parents are responsible for coordinating communication and support for your classroom teacher's volunteer/special event/special project needs.
- **Classroom Support:** Each teacher has a list of jobs including occasional grocery purchasing, sewing repairs for dress-up clothes, light carpentry needs, and pet helper. Find something that works for you! Teachers conduct sign-ups for these jobs at Back to School Night.



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Snow Days/ Inclement Weather Protocol



All closures will be posted on our website and communicated by email. CCPC makes independent decisions for "snow days" but generally follows DCPS.

If DCPS has a delayed opening of one or two hours, CCPC will open at 10:00 a.m.

We may choose to close even when DCPS is open under special circumstances related to particular concerns around our facility with neighborhood road plowing and available parking as well as sidewalk safety/clearing.

We do not makeup or refund days lost due to weather emergencies.

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Mandatory Drills

There are three OSSE-required safety drills:


- Fire

Although teachers are always prepared for a possible lockdown, we do not practice lockdown drills until the second half of the school year.




Future CCPC Students


