

PART NUMBERS


Patchcord part numbers are made up using the table below. The part number is 18 digits in length.

The part number always starts with the letters PAT to denote that it is a patchcord. This is followed by a dash and then a two digit code for the length of the patchcord. Another dash is followed by a two letter code. The first letter represents the connector on one end, and the second letter represents the connector on the other end of the patchcord. Another dash is next, followed by a single letter code to denote the fiber type of the patchcord. After another dash a two digit code denotes the fiber diameter. Another dash is then followed by the termination type and a final dash is followed by a single letter code for the sheath color of the patchcord.

Note: Patchcords must be ordered in 1 meter increments.

Ordering Guide

Example: Patchcord, 5 meters, SC/APC Connectors on both ends, G657A1 Fiber, 2mm diameter, Simplex, Yellow.



The patchcord color code can be seen in the table below.



- The fibers and the buffer are both colored to ensure ease of identification when stripped.
- All connectors are supplied with ceramic ferrules.


Pigtail part numbers are made up using the table below. The part number is 18 digits in length.

The part number always starts with the letters PIG to denote that it is a pigtail. This is followed by a dash and then a three digit code for the length of the pigtail. Another dash is followed by a single letter code. This represents the connector type of the pigtail. Another dash is next, followed by a single letter code to denote the fiber type of the pigtail. After another dash a two digit code denotes the fiber diameter. Another dash is then followed by the termination type and a final dash is followed by a single letter code for the color and number of pigtails.

Note: Pigtails can only be ordered in 0.5 meter increments up to 10 meters. Above 10 meters pigtails must be ordered in 1 meter increments.

Ordering Guide

Example: Pigtail, 5 Meters, SC/APC Connector, G657A1 Fiber, 0.9mm diameter, Simplex, Pack of 12 colors.



The pigtail color code can be seen in the table below. When ordering sets of pigtails, they are supplied with the colors from 1 to 12. For example if a set of 6 pigtails is ordered the colors supplied are Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Grey, White.
