BEAUTIFICATION SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Below is an artist's rendering of LSS's original stained glass yearzeit board project, which called for four (4) stained glass light boxes to be installed among the second floor yearzeit boards. We have several 22" x 48" stained glass panels from the old building that we have stored since moving into the new building, and we propose that our vendor would fabricate light boxes using the stained glass from the old shul and install them on the second floor, and that an electrician would run power behind each box prior to installation. Each lightbox that is sponsored (at the cost of \$6,800) will have on it a yearzeit plaque that will be lit up throughout the year, detailing who sponsored the lightbox and including "in memory of" wording. So far, we have secured two sponsors for this project, and we are looking for two more. The project cannot commence until we have all four sponsors secured. 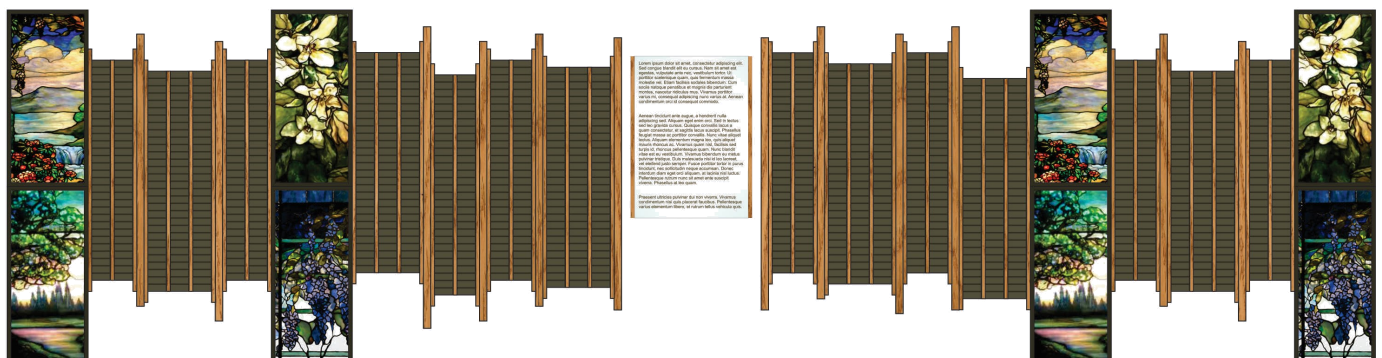
