***Offsite* Sunday, August 20th: 5K Cancer Schlep: 9:00am:** You and your family have the opportunity to perform a wonderful Mitzvah. The American Friends of Rabin Medical Center is holding, for the 12th straight year, a 5K walk/run in Central Park (beginning at the Naumburg Bandshell at 72nd Street) to benefit research and raise awareness for the BRCA 1+2 Gene Mutation and its deadly link to breast, ovarian and prostate cancer. Three percent of all Jews of Ashkenazy ancestry carry this mutation and among this group more than 50% will develop cancer in their lifetime. Rabin Medical Center, one of Israel's most prominent hospitals, located just outside of Tel Aviv, stands at the forefront of international efforts to test, treat and conduct cutting edge research to battle this deadly disease.
