

Senior Day 2019



The 2019 Modesto Junior College Senior took place on Friday, October 4, 2019. 240 senior high school students in California attended Senior Day so they could come tour and learn about the MJC Agriculture department. The students came to learn about the different opportunities the MJC Agriculture department offers. In the ACE Pavilion the students had the opportunity to walk around and learn about all of the degrees and certificates within the department. In the Annex, the students were able to see the hands on opportunities for the animal units as the following brought some of their animals from the unit: dairy, swine, equine, sheep and poultry unit. The different clubs at MJC were also on display for the students to see. The clubs on display included: Young Farmers, Animal Science, Poultry Club, Pull Truck, Quarter Scale and Ag Ambassadors.
