Week 6: The Gospel of Reconciliation

Reconciliation lies at the very center of the gospel. "All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and has given us the ministry of reconciliation" (2 Corinthians 5:18 NRSVUE). Through the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ, God has broken down the barriers of hostility that divide us and has restored us to himself. Having received this grace, we are called to become agents of healing, renewal, and restored relationships. Our lives testify to the transforming power of God, who can soften hearts that have been hardened by generations of suffering, fear, resentment, and distrust.

For decades, the people of North and South Korea have lived beneath the painful weight of separation. Many have grown resigned to the belief that this division is permanent and that the wounds are too deep to be healed. Yet the ministry of reconciliation entrusted to the Church proclaims a greater hope. No conflict, broken relationship, or national division lies beyond the redeeming love of Christ.

This week, let us pray for God's reconciling grace to bring healing, restoration, and renewed hope to the Korean Peninsula and to every region of the world burdened by conflict and division.

Week 6 Prayer Guide

1. Pray for greater trust and understanding between North and South Korea, and for peaceful dialogue between their leaders.
2. Pray for God's healing to touch the deep wounds left by colonization, war, and division, bringing reconciliation, restoration, and renewed hope to the Korean people.
3. Pray for lasting peace and healing in the Korean Peninsula.
4. Pray for protection, strength, and freedom for those who are oppressed and suffering in North Korea and in other places of conflict.
5. Pray for the Church to remain faithful in bearing witness to God's hope in our broken world.
