~Debris Removal

Phase 2 (currently underway): Crews from the Army Corps of Engineers remove non-hazardous debris from properties at no cost to homeowners.

- You can OPT IN by filling out a Right of Entry form

- You can OPT OUT of the free government program and hire an approved contractor by filling out an opt-out form.

~**For everyone:** All Federal and State tax filing deadlines have been extended to October 15, 2025, for all county residents and businesses. This includes individual income tax returns and payments, as well as estimated tax payments originally due in 2025. This deadline extension is automatic; you don't have to file anything until October.
