Week 3: God's Heart for Peace

As we begin our third week of prayer for Korea, we fix our eyes on the peace of God that restores what is broken, reconciles what is divided, and brings healing where there has been deep pain. For many decades, the Korean Peninsula has carried the weight of unresolved conflict. Its division continues to produce fear, tension, and uncertainty, affecting not only the people of Korea but also the wider world.

Nonetheless, we place our hope in this gospel truth: Christ is our peace! Ephesians 2:14 reminds us, "For he is our peace; in his flesh he has made both into one and has broken down the dividing wall, that is, the hostility between us." Through Jesus, the walls that separate people, communities, and nations are not beyond God's power to tear down.

We are called to live as witnesses to this reconciling peace. This week, let us pray for Korea, for our own nation, and for all places where God's healing and wholeness are desperately needed.

Week 3 Prayer Guide

1. Pray for the Church to reflect the peace of Christ, bearing witness to reconciliation, forgiveness, and healing among the Korean people.
2. Pray for Korean and global leaders to seek peace over power, pursuing wisdom, humility, and justice for the good of all people.
3. Pray for lasting peace, healing, and reconciliation between North and South Korea.
4. Pray for protection, strength, and freedom for those who are oppressed and suffering in North Korea and in other places of conflict.
5. Pray for the Church to remain faithful in bearing witness to God's justice and hope in our broken world.
