~**The Small Business Administration** (SBA) administers low-interest loans for individual homeowners as well as businesses. Go to sba.gov/california-wildfires for information on eligibility and applications.

~**For everyone:** All Federal and State tax filing deadlines have been extended to October 15, 2025, for all county residents and businesses. This includes individual income tax returns and payments, as well as estimated tax payments originally due in 2025. This deadline extension is automatic; you don't have to file anything until October.
