

Opportunity to Join the Presbytery Team for the 2026 Property Reinvention Cohort

The PC(USA) Office of Faithful Innovation has selected our presbytery to participate in the 2026 Property Reinvention Cohort, a churchwide learning opportunity focused on faithful, innovative, and forward-looking approaches to church property and ministry.

This cohort will help presbyteries re-imagine property not simply as a burden to manage, but as a strategic asset for mission, sustainability, and community impact.

Each participating presbytery may bring a team of up to five people total. We are seeking a few additional people from our presbytery who may be interested in joining this team. Space is limited, and final team composition will be determined in consultation with presbytery leadership.

The in-person gathering will take place in Minneapolis, beginning at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 17, 2026, and concluding at noon on Saturday, September 19, 2026. Team members are also expected to participate in monthly virtual gatherings on the second Wednesday of each month at 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time, beginning October 14, 2026.

There is no registration fee. PC(USA) covers facilitation, hotel accommodations for two nights, group meals, and venue costs. Participating mid councils are responsible for travel and personal expenses.

We are especially looking for people with experience or interest in property, finance, mission, congregational vitality, community partnerships, affordable housing, new worshipping communities, legal or governance matters, or long-term stewardship.
