



HONORS COMMITTEE UPDATE

The 2022 Austin Branch Garabed A. Harutunian Civil Engineer of the Year Award is Tyler P. Dube, P.E..

Tyler is a native Austinite, earned the rank of Eagle Scout in the 8th grade; and was twice named All-State trumpeter and band drum major at the Lyndon Baines Johnson High School in Austin as a Liberal Arts and Science Academy Magnet Program Graduate. Tyler graduated from the University of Texas at Austin in 2010 with a BS in Civil Engineering, while also serving as the solo 2009-2010 Longhorn Band Drum Major. The Longhorn Band Major is selected by a panel of peers and University staff and is the leader of the 400-member marching band responsible for teaching drill, leading rehearsals, and conducting half-time shows for crowds averaging over 100,000 people.

In 2003-2011, Tyler created and ran the Dube Lawn Service company that paid for his college and provided opportunity for other students to work towards graduating debt-free as well. His company provided lawn maintenance and holiday decorating service to over 70 clients and had cumulative revenue of over \$225K, working two days per week between classes.



Tyler is a Project Manager for Pape-Dawson Engineers, having started with them in 2011. He is responsible for the training and assignments for up to 15 EITs and PEs state-wide. Tyler's experienced at schematic and PS&E development for roadway, drainage, signing, pavement marking, utility, stormwater pollution protection, and traffic control disciplines. His top major professional achievements include being lead developer of mobile applications for data collection, data management, and daily field observation reports; scripting innovative automation tools for Microsoft Office and Bentley software for rapid PS&E development utilized by the Pape-Dawson state-wide transportation team; and leading comprehensive user training program for PowerGEOPAK company-wide 3D design software implementation.

Outside of work, Tyler has given back to his community and profession through involvement with ASCE at the Branch and State levels since 2012. He served the San Antonio and Austin Branches on Engineer of the Year Banquet and Sponsorship Committees, Student Chapter Liaison, and currently serves on the Austin Branch board as the Vice President -Programs. At the state level he facilitated the 2013 Centennial Grant Program and served on the board as a 2015-2017 Director at Large. He volunteers his time each year with mentorship of young students engaged in STEM activities and supports the next generation of civil engineers as a guest judge for senior design courses at the University of

Perhaps Tyler can be best described by the words from one of his former bosses, "He doesn't just come into the office to design projects, produce plans and go home. He supports those around him with technical training, he gets involved with ASCE to promote the civil engineering profession and community, he's creative when it comes to fundraising for causes in alignment with his personal and community values, and he maintains a strong bond with his family."

Tyler and his wife, Sara, have two children, Sloane and Levi. Please congratulate Tyler on this much deserved award. He is a true asset to his family, profession and ASCE.
