

MEETING TOPIC CITY OF AUSTIN'S WATER FORWARD PROGRAM

ASCE Austin Branch is excited to host Marisa Flores Gonzalez, Water Resources Team Supervisor with Austin Water who will be presenting on Water Forward. The Water Forward Plan is the City of Austin's 100year integrated water resource plan. The foundational Water Forward 2018 plan is a roadmap for a diversified, resilient, and sustainable water future for Austin. Austin Water has begun implementation of key strategies in the plan, including advanced metering infrastructure and identifying favorable locations for an Aquifer Storage and Recovery pilot. Austin Water is now performing the 2024 update to Water Forward which includes several new elements, including updated climate and hydrology analyses, a more robust approach to incorporating uncertainty, and development of an equity and affordability framework for strategy evaluation.

Marisa Flores Gonzalez

Marisa Flores Gonzalez leads the Water Resources Team at Austin Water and serves as the project manager for Water Forward, Austin's 100-year Integrated Water Resource Plan. Ms. Flores Gonzalez has twelve years of experience working in local government and utilities in multiple areas including water supply, water distribution, wastewater collection, and stormwater management planning. She brings a holistic approach to water planning, with a belief in the value of community engagement and adaptive management to create a resilient and equitable water future for the Austin community. Ms. Flores Gonzalez holds a B.A. in Geography and the Environment from the University of Texas at Austin and a Master's in Public Administration from Texas State University.

In addition to the technical presentation, we will also be installing the incoming 2023-2024 ASCE Austin Branch Board of Directors.
