Welcome to the new year!

Please join us at our next luncheon on January 17, where we'll hear from Brandye Hendrickson, TxDOT Deputy Executive Director, who will update us on the latest news with TxDOT. Registration links and additional information can be found on page 5 of this newsletter.

As everyone knows, inflation has been very high recently, and unfortunately the ASCE Austin Branch has seen our costs increase. Starting with the upcoming January 2023 luncheon, we'll be raising luncheon rates for "Members" and "Non-Members" by \$5, from \$30 to \$35 and from \$35 to \$40, respectively. We hate having to raise rates, but I believe we're still in line with other local professional orgs, and we're proud that this is our first increase since 2017. This increase will also help us continue to offer reduced rates Students, Government Employees, Life Members, and Retirees. And of course, we're still accepting donations in any amount from those of you joining us virtually. #### **2023 STATE LEGISLATIVE DRIVE-IN**


Be on the lookout for the upcoming Legislative Drive-in--the event will occur in early Spring 2023 at the state capital right here in Austin, Texas.


