Due to the recent COVID-19 outbreak:

All hearings will be held under the following conditions until further notice:

Upon your arrival at District Court 39-4-02, remain in your vehicle. If you have walked to the office, please remain outside. Please call us at 717-485-4842 to advise that you have arrived for your hearing.

If you are driving, let us know the make, model and color of your vehicle along with your telephone number. If you are walking, we will just need your telephone number. When the court is ready to proceed with your hearing, we will call you on the number you provide. At this time, you will enter the facility by using the north entrance, this is the door facing the parking lot. The District Court staff will open the door for you and you will enter the courtroom directly by following the posted signs.

While in the court facility, social distancing of at least 6 feet shall be maintained. Also, mouth and nose coverings will be required of anyone entering the court facility.

We will be limiting attendance at this time, so, please do not bring anyone who is not necessary to your hearing. If you have questions about who may or may not attend, please call this office prior to your hearing for instructions.
