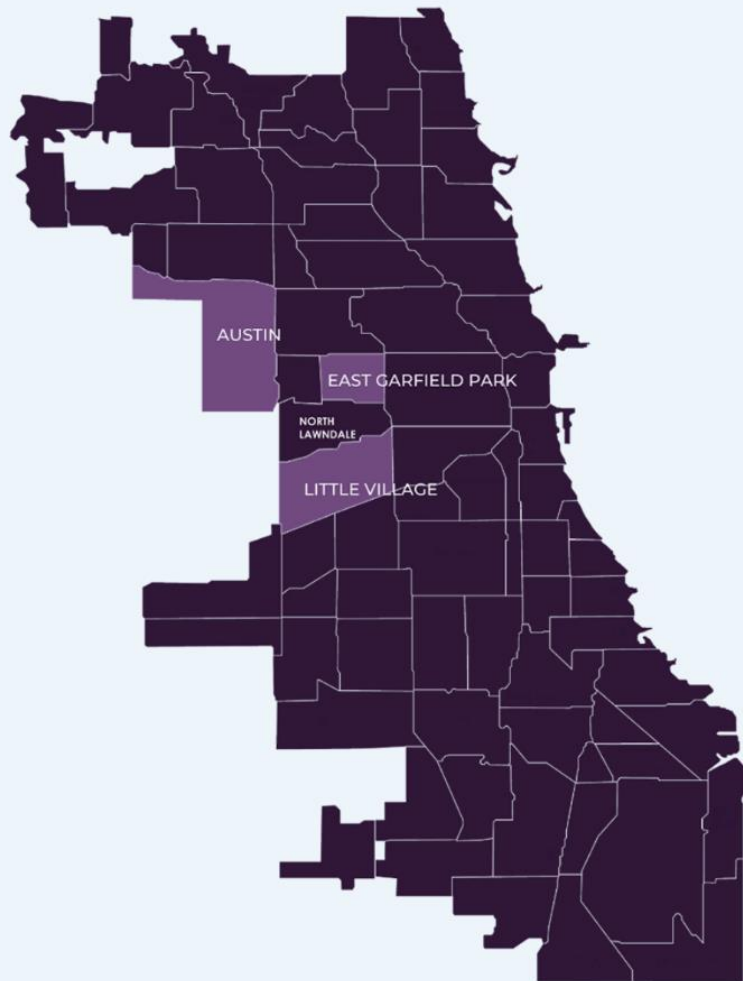

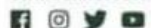

Who Can Help Me if I Am a Victim of Identity Theft?

- The **U.S. Federal Trade Commission** can assist you in resolving the financial problems that may result from identity theft if you file a complaint.
- The **Illinois Attorney General** has the power to file criminal charges against the person who stole your identity.
- The **U.S. Postal Service** can help you obtain the phone number of the nearest Postal Inspector.
- The **U.S. Social Security Office** can verify that your name and income have been reported correctly.
