Indiana Bar Foundation Announces Middle and High School We the People Competition

INDIANAPOLIS - The Indiana Bar Foundation (Foundation) has released the names of the 33 middle and 13 high school classes participating in the 2021 We the People contest. We the People is a curriculum-based national program promoting civic education and responsibility for upper elementary through high school students. Indiana's We the People program annually reaches 13-thousand students and more than 100 educators. Since its inception in 1987, more than 30 million students and 75,000 educators have participated nationally in the We the People program.

“The Indiana Bar Foundation is proud to support this innovative educational initiative. With our assistance, educators work with students to research and prepare for the simulated Congressional hearing-styled competition. Our students are simply amazing and are great ambassadors for the state,” said Foundation President and CEO Charles Dunlap.

Participating classes begin (virtual) regional competition on November 2, culminating with the top five teams from each of four regions advancing to the state championships December 7 and 8.
