Prom is one of the final “marking moments” for our senior class. It is a moment, one of the final ones, for our senior class to come together for an exceptional dance and enjoy the few days that remain in their senior year. In order to ensure a successful evening as well as the safety of our students, please take a few moments to review the following information.

Tickets sales will begin on Friday, May 3rd at 8:00am. [Click this link](#) to purchase tickets starting May 3rd at 8:00am. Tickets are \$30 per person. After 8:00am on Friday, May 10th tickets prices increase to \$60 per person.

Drop off will be at the Legacy Gate at US Bank Stadium. All students who are driving are welcome to park in the Mills Fleet Farm parking garage (enter on South 3rd Street).

All students and guests are required to show photo identification upon entering the dance; school ID is acceptable. We will accept a driver's license, permit (with a photo) as well. A student **without photo ID will not be admitted** to the dance.

Bringing a guest from another school – completed [guest dance form](#) must be returned to the activities office by Friday, May 10th at 3:00pm. Rules for bringing a guest to an Edina High School dance are stated on the form.

Prom is held at **US Bank Stadium** on May 11th from 8:00 -11:00; **DOORS CLOSE AT 10:00pm (no admittance after 10:00pm)!**

Students may be subject to a **breath screening search upon entry to the event**. This screening search ensures a safe and positive high school experience. By purchasing their tickets and attending this event, they have provided consent to be breathalyzed and waive any related claims that may arise from the search. If you elect not to provide consent to this search, they will be denied entry to the event without refund or other compensation. All district policies are enforced at this event.
