Thank you for allowing us the opportunity to have our voices heard this evening.

Clearly, the damage this year has been done and the most we can hope for is to lessen the disruption as best as possible.

Going forward, we would like to request a confirmation on the number that District defines as capacity for Arcadia High School, what that is based on should be faculty, text books, desks, 33 in a class, safety, security, parking, traffic, etc. and not outdated study on what our square footage is. Please let us know when you will have that reasonable number.

As you heard tonight, the District might be low on numbers but it is crystal clear that Arcadia is not and it is absolutely unacceptable for us to fund the other schools at the expense of our students and staff. If open enrollment students want SUSD and Arcadia is full, they should go to the schools that have room.
