



What is the SUSD Maintenance and Operations Budget Override?

The last time voters approved a Budget Override was in 2014. The override must be approved every five years for SUSD to continue receiving that additional 15% in funding for the school district's budget. Voters must now renew the override or funding will automatically be reduced by \$6.5 million a year.

Renewing the SUSD 2019 Budget Override will provide approximately \$19 million a year through 2025 without increasing your property tax rate.

SUSD already has one of the lowest tax rates in the Valley.

Renewing the Budget Override will maintain the quality of Scottsdale schools – which, in turn, will increase property values and enhance surrounding neighborhoods. It keeps teachers' salaries competitive, so SUSD continues attracting and retaining the most highly qualified educators.

Most importantly, students will continue receiving the excellent education they deserve. In addition, the override will:

- Keep full-day kindergarten
- Maintain current class sizes
- Retain music, arts, world languages, athletic programs and extra curricular activities
- Continue an emphasis on technology
