### Important Information and FAQ's

#### What are the dates? (7:45AM – 1:30PM)

- **Session 1:** Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday, June 13<sup>th</sup>
  - Registration Deadline: May 22<sup>nd</sup>
- **Session 2:** Thursday, June 15<sup>th</sup> – Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup>
  - \*No class on 6/19
  - Registration Deadline: June 7<sup>TH</sup>
- In-person classes are located at Coronado High School

#### What is the fee?

- \$25/semester course for current SUSD students; \$200/semester course for out of district students
- One Course = .5 credit (1.0 credit is needed for one full year of a course)
- There may be additional fees for specific courses, such as lab fees, etc.
- There will be no refunds after the first day, regardless of the reason for the request. This includes: \$25 course fee, applicable lab fees, etc.

#### What is the attendance policy?

- Classroom: Due to the necessary number of instructional minutes, if a student is absent for more than 1 day, she/he will be dropped from the course.
- Online: Students must log into their course by the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the session or will be dropped from the course.
- No refunds will be issued for classes dropped due to attendance.

#### Can a student take more than one class at a time?

- You may only take more than one class per session if approved in writing by the AP at your school (please contact your counselor)

#### When are final exams?

- Final exams will be administered online for online courses. Students must take the course final exam at the date and time that is pre-determined by the instructor.
- For in-person courses, final exams will be administered in-person.

### Registration Information

#### Check with school counselor to verify correct course code(s)

- Core courses ending in even #'s = 1<sup>st</sup> semester course (Ex: Algebra I, 4410 is 1<sup>st</sup> semester Algebra I)
- Core courses ending in odd #'s = 2<sup>nd</sup> semester course (Ex: Algebra I, 4411 is 2<sup>nd</sup> semester Algebra I)

#### Registration:

- Registration begins on Monday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
