

PSAT Day General Information

- The PSAT will be administered to sophomores and juniors on **Wed, Oct 16**.
- No registration is required. The PSAT is free for all FCPS sophomores and juniors.
- PSAT day is an early release day (12:55 pm) for all students.
- PSAT practice materials are online at www.collegeboard.org. Sophomores and juniors received a PSAT Student Guide & Practice Test via their English classes.
- PSAT testing locations will be posted on Google Classroom sites on Wed, Oct 9. Students with accommodations will also receive testing time and location information via their FCPS Gmail accounts on Oct 9.
- Students will need two #2 pencils (**mechanical pencils not allowed**) and an approved calculator. See Google Classroom sites for approved list.

- Note: FCPS is no longer administering the PSAT 8/9. 9th grade students will participate in a high school transition program on Oct 16.

PSAT Pre-Survey is Voluntary
