Join a Langley group of 30 travelers — Langley students, parents and friends are invited — for a nine-day trip to England and Scotland next summer, June 16-24. This is an incredible opportunity to experience European culture among a group of family and friends. Students can even earn three college prep credits for the trip. The trip takes place right after school ends (June 12), to not interfere with other summer activities. It is led by Mrs. McCommas, Langley history teacher and special education teacher, and chaperoned by Langley History Department faculty. The trip is sponsored by FCPS and organized by the World Strides Company.

Our group will tour London and visit historical landmarks, including Westminster Abbey and Buckingham Palace, as well as the famous Tower of London where the Crown jewels are located. Optional site visits, time permitting, in London include the Churchill War Rooms, the British Museum and the world-famous National Gallery art museum.

Also while we're in London, the Union of European Football Associations will be sponsoring a city festival, which will bring the city of London to life with a celebration of arts, culture, music — and soccer! Our group will join English football fans to watch a EURO 2020 Group D football game, broadcast from Wembley Stadium on jumbo screens in Fan Zones throughout the city on June 19. We'll visit the London Football Village and be a part of the ultimate UEFA Euro 2020 party. We'll tour Oxford, the world-renowned university and also site of some famous scenes of the Harry Potter movies. We'll also visit Shakespeare's theatre and birthplace in Stratford-upon-Avon.

In Scotland, we'll tour the magnificent Edinburgh Castle, walk the Royal Mile and tour the unique city of Edinburgh, enjoy Scottish scones and learn some Scottish dancing.
